Volunteer Opportunity: We're looking for a volunteer to assist in our lunch canteen on Fridays. If you're able to help, please let me know!

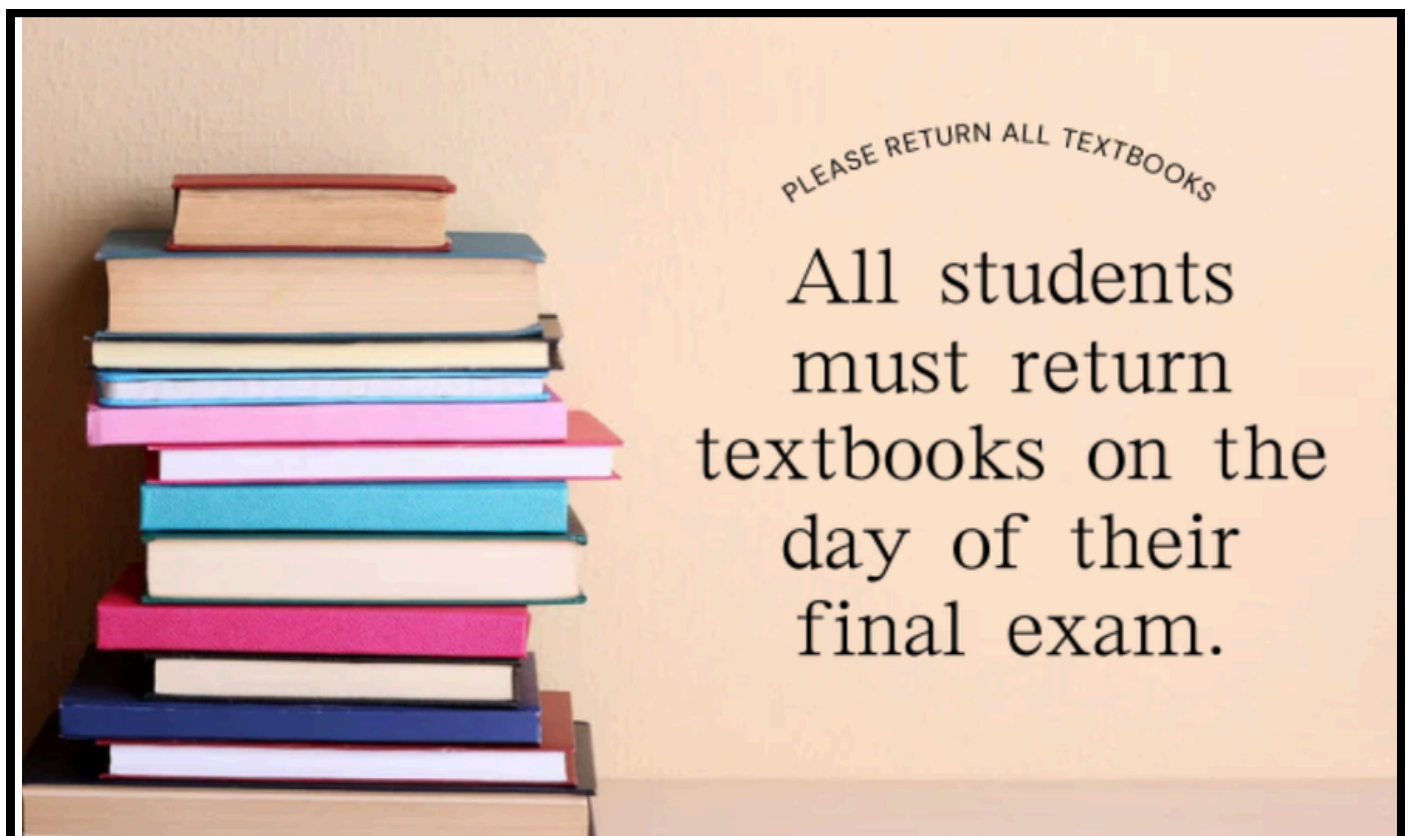

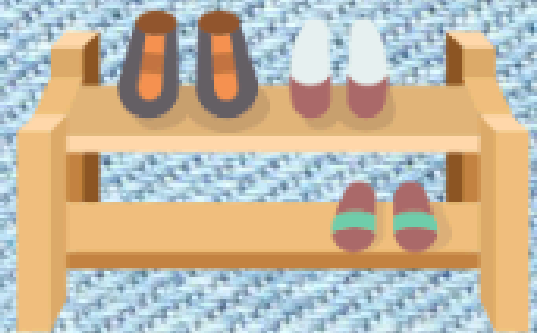
