Prior to the winter break, our grade 10 students engaged in rigorous post-secondary and career pathway breakout sessions during Connect that were hosted by our academic. Using survey data collected from grade 10 students, each individual was assigned to a session based on their identified interests. Each session contained 10-25 students, and was hosted by one of our academic counsellors. These smaller group, focused sessions allowed our counsellors and grade 10 students to connect regarding relevant and integral information regarding their high school completion plan, post-secondary entrance requirements and career pathway economic outlook. Feedback from students has been positive and we aim to provide increasing academic counselling support for our grade 10 students moving forward.

Our grade 12s have now received their diploma exam marks. We are proud of the effort our students put into these exams and their progression towards graduation. All our grade 12 students are now required to complete their Application to Graduate. This application ensures all students have met, or are on pace to meet, all graduation requirements by the end of the school year. Parents, you will be required to sign this application as well. All applications to graduate are due March 12th. They can be found outside Mr. Payne's office, on the HJ Cody Website or the Grad Google Classroom. Please take note that there is a grad parent meeting on March 5th at 7 pm in the Fine Arts Center.

Safety Reminder: The lane closest to the front doors is designated for buses only between 8:00–8:25 AM and 3:00–3:30 PM. 
